By integrating STEM technology into schools and pioneering vocational excellence through the *Akademi Dalam Industri (ADI)*, we have ensured that the next generation of Johor's talent is not just educated, but employable. Our focus remains on bridging the gap between academic potential and economic reality, ensuring no student is left behind due to their background.

STRENGTHENING ADI FOR SUCCESS:
ACHIEVING FIRST GRADUATES

Dedicated improvements in academic delivery and student support contributed to strong academic and skills achievements for Cohort 1: Overall, 22 students graduated with 21 passing SPM, 22 earning the MPAK certificate, 22 achieving SKM Levels 2 and 3, and one student scoring straight A's.

This progress culminated on 9 September 2025, when 22 Johor youths from B40 families became ADI's first-ever graduates. Equipped with SPM, MPAK, and SKM Levels 2 and 3 certifications, along with hands-on industry experience through partners such as QSR Stores Sdn Bhd and the Department of Skills Development, they are now prepared to enter the workforce with confidence - a major milestone for their families and for Johor's wider skilled-talent development efforts.

Programme Objectives

- ▶ Open pathways for underprivileged youths to access vocational training, leading to better employment and higher education opportunities.
- ▶ Develop future-ready talents that align with Johor's and Malaysia's vision of building a skilled, employable workforce.
- ▶ Equip students with industry-relevant skills by combining classroom learning with hands-on experience in KFC restaurants.

Programme Impacts

- ▶ **22** students graduated as the first cohort of ADI apprentices.
- ▶ **96%** passed SPM; **100%** passed MPAK; all obtained SKM Level 2 and 3, with one trainee scoring straight A's.
- ▶ Trained a total of **89** students from 2023 to 2025, with 25 in 2023, 38 in 2024, and 26 in 2025, consisting of 16 in QSR and 10 in KPJ Healthcare Berhad, combining classroom learning with real industry practice.

SCHOOLS THROUGH STEM**

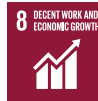
Yayasan JCorp, in collaboration with Yayasan Sultan Ibrahim Johor, delivered Smart Farming Greenhouses to SMK Seri Medan, Batu Pahat, and SMK Buloh Kasap, Segamat, as part of its Sustainable School - STEM Programme. Powered by Internet of Things (IoT) technology, the greenhouses enable year-round food production and smart agricultural monitoring.

Seed Germination Training Sessions, conducted by Urban Farm Tech, equipped teachers and students with hands-on skills needed to operate the facilities - bridging the gap between theoretical knowledge and real-world application while inspiring the next generation of agri-tech innovators.

- ▶ Increase teachers' and students' knowledge regarding smart agriculture concepts.
- ▶ Provide teachers and students with practical exposure to innovative seed germination and crop management techniques.
- ▶ Support STEM education initiatives in schools by integrating science, technology, engineering, and mathematics elements in activities outside the classroom.

Programme Impacts

- ▶ **8** Smart Farming Greenhouses completed in total.
- ▶ **4,000** leafy vegetables were planted, demonstrating productive cultivation.
- ▶ **240** students and **60** teachers were trained, building critical skills in agri-tech.
- ▶ Greenhouses can generate more than **RM1,000** per harvest, showcasing economic potential.

REFINING OUR ENGLISH TUITION PROJECT
FOR ENHANCED LEARNING

The English Tuition Project continued to strengthen its impact through a series of refinement and development sessions with the Johor State Education Department (JPNJ). From 17-19 March 2025, 25 expert English teachers gathered at Sungai Johor Eco Retreat, Kota Tinggi, for a three-day module designed to enhance teaching strategies in reading, essay writing, grammar, conversational skills, and listening, with all content fully aligned to the latest SPM English examination requirements.

This was followed by a second refinement workshop from 8-10 April 2025 at Fives Hotel, Johor Bahru, where the same cohort of teachers further improved and finalised the Booster B1 Module. The momentum culminated on 21 July 2025 with the official launch of the B1 Booster - ACE Your SPM English Module at Menara KOMTAR, developed to support 39 participating secondary schools.

This initiative reinforces Yayasan JCorp's commitment to teacher empowerment, high-quality English instruction, and stronger student outcomes across Johor. Together, we are shaping a stronger foundation in English for future leaders.

- ▶ Enhance the Southern Stellar Module for greater effectiveness.
- ▶ Ensure strengthened collaboration and incorporation of high-quality materials to maximise student learning outcomes.
- ▶ Develop a final module that aligns with SPM English exam requirements and addresses common student challenges.

- ▶ **25** expert English teachers involved throughout all refinement phases.
- ▶ **39** secondary schools benefiting from the module in 2025.
- ▶ **15,926** students have benefitted from Yayasan JCorp's tuition projects to date.
- ▶ Over **RM2.5** million invested in tuition projects since 2012.

LANGUAGE CARNIVALS 2025:
JOHOR SHINES ON STATE AND
NATIONAL STAGES

Two major language carnivals were hosted in Johor in 2025.

From 3-4 September, Yayasan JCorp partnered with JPNJ to host the Johor State Level English Language Carnival 2025 at the Raja Zarith Sofiah Library, UTM Johor. The two-day celebration brought together 250 district champions selected from 10,265 participants across 11 districts, competing in Scrabble, Dare to Spell, Poetry Recitation, Public Speaking, Storytelling, and Mini Documentary production. Batu Pahat emerged as the Primary Overall District Champion, while Kulai won the Secondary category. SMK Bandar Putra 2, Kulai, secured the special award for Best Impromptu Poem.

From 27-30 October 2025, Johor hosted the inaugural National-Level Language Unity Carnival, which for the first time combined Bahasa Melayu and English co-academic competitions. The Johor contingent achieved notable success:

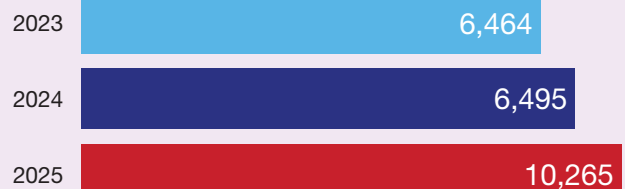

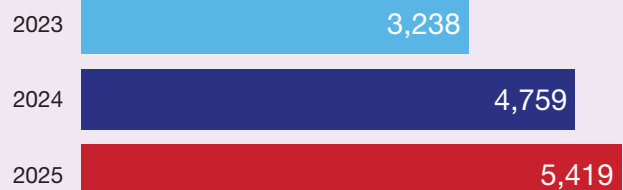
**AMPLIFYING YOUTH VOICES:
CHORAL SPEAKING -
JOHOR STATE LEVEL 2025**

Held at KOMTAR JBCC, Johor Bahru, this collaborative event between Yayasan JCorp and JPNJ united students from all 11 districts under the theme “Digital Dreams, Real Futures.” Students demonstrated confidence, creativity, and digital readiness through powerful English performances that fostered language proficiency and digital literacy.

The competition drew 5,419 participants statewide, attracted 26,411 visitors, and garnered more than one million social media views. SK Yong Peng went on to be crowned National Champion in the Primary Category.

Programme Objectives

- ▶ Empower students' verbal communication skills and expressions.
- ▶ Promote overall English understanding and usage.
- ▶ Create a platform for students in Johor to express their creativity in English, while enhancing their public-speaking confidence.

Programme Impacts

- ▶ A total of **5,419** students from 11 districts participated in the Yayasan JCorp Choral Speaking, while 440 students participated at the Johor State Level.
- ▶ Attracted **26,411** local visitors to KOMTAR JBCC for the Choral Speaking Competition.
- ▶ Accumulated over **1 million** views on Yayasan JCorp's social media from 28 July to 24 August 2025, while the number of followers increased by 2,300.
- ▶ **SK Yong Peng** made history by being crowned Champion of the Choral Speaking National Challenge (Primary Category), while SMK Yong Peng secured 5th place in the Secondary Category at PICC Putrajaya.

EMPOWERING B40 STUDENTS
THROUGH HIGHER EDUCATION**

Since 2017, Yayasan JCorp has been dedicated to easing the financial strain on B40 families and students pursuing higher education, enabling them to concentrate fully on their studies. Through targeted financial aid, the foundation empowers deserving individuals throughout Malaysia, ensuring equitable access to education and helping to level the playing field for future success. This effort cultivates future leaders who will contribute to Malaysia's growth and prosperity.

To be eligible, students must be enrolled full-time and come from B40 households. Financial assistance is provided for Certificate and Diploma programmes, as well as Bachelor's and Master's degrees.





Programme Objectives

- ▶ Alleviate financial burdens by providing financial aid to B40 families.
- ▶ Ensure students from underprivileged backgrounds have equal opportunities to pursue higher education.
- ▶ Invest in the education of B40 students to cultivate and support the development of future leaders.

Programme Impacts

- ▶ More than **1,800** students supported since inception.
- ▶ Approximately **RM1.15** million dedicated to underprivileged students to date.
- ▶ **205** students empowered in 2025, with an investment of **RM180,000**.

ACCA SCHOLARSHIP FOR PROFESSIONAL ACCOUNTING EDUCATION

Building on the JCorp Chartered Accountancy Programme, the ACCA Scholarship for Professional Accounting Education has been offered since 2022. It aims to develop human capital in professional accounting by providing financial assistance to outstanding Malaysian students pursuing ACCA qualifications. The programme enhances equity by extending opportunities to individuals - particularly those from B40 families - who may otherwise lack access to quality education.

RM200,000 was allocated for this round of scholarships, funded through Wakalah contributions from Waqaf An-Nur. Out of a total of 11 scholars, three affiliated graduates have commenced their careers as professional accountants in 2025, demonstrating the programme's tangible impact on developing skilled financial professionals from underserved communities.

- ▶ Support the development of human capital in professional accounting.
- ▶ Increase access to high-quality professional education and qualifications.

DIGITAL LITERACY PROGRAMME
FOR RURAL & B40 STUDENTS

Yayasan JCorp, JPNJ, and AFFIN Group launched the DigiLIT Programme at SK Sayong Pinang, Kulai, to bridge the digital divide for rural and B40 students. Three schools - SK Sikijang, SK Belokok, and SK Sayong Pinang (an Orang Asli community school) - each received 20 laptops and an interactive smartboard, supported by a digital literacy planning module to equip students with essential 21st-century technology skills.

The ceremony was officiated by Yang Berhormat Tuan Aznan bin Tamin, Chairman of the Johor State Education and Information Committee, reflecting the Johor State Government's strong commitment to advancing inclusive and equitable education across all communities. The event also featured a gotong-royong activity involving teachers, parents, and the local community, symbolising unity and collective effort in supporting holistic education development in rural schools.

Programme Objectives

- ▶ Bridge the digital divide by providing access to technology and digital learning tools for students in rural and low-enrolment schools.
- ▶ Enhance digital literacy skills among primary school students to prepare them for the future.
- ▶ Empower B40 students through equitable access to resources that foster creativity, confidence, and technological proficiency.

Programme Impacts

- ▶ **60** laptops and three interactive smartboards provided to three rural schools, creating interactive and engaging classrooms.
- ▶ **RM196,300** allocated for the Yayasan JCorp Digital Literacy Education programme in 2025.
- ▶ Potentially benefits **283** students in total.
